Installation Instructions

1. Introduction

This document gives instructions and guidelines for making a Pour-A-Lid to match your pool deck finish. The Pour-A-Lid can be used with plain concrete, stamped concrete, raised aggregate, stone pavers and many other new pool deck finishes.

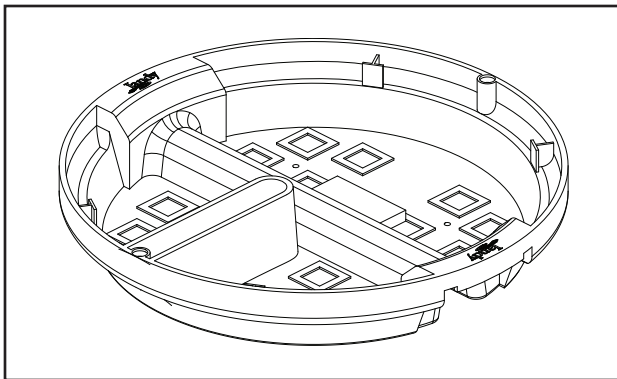


Figure 1. Pour-A-Lid

2. Pouring a Pour-A-Lid

For best results, follow the following guidelines when making a pour style Pour-A-Lid.

- Keep the Pour-A-Lid and collar separate during pouring of concrete.
- Portions of the concrete will be thin, so plan on pouring the concrete in a shady area to slow down the curing.

- Once the concrete is thoroughly mixed and workable, it should be placed in the Pour-A-Lid before the mixture becomes too stiff.
- Work concrete into lower area of the Pour-A-Lid cavity first and then add successive layers so that all corners are filled with no gaps.
- Use a Mason trowel to compact and smooth the concrete within the Pour-A-Lid to eliminate potential flaws, such as honeycombs and air pockets.
- Keep the slot area and screw holes clear of concrete.

3. Installing Stone pavers in a Pour-A-Lid

For best results, follow the following guidelines when using stone pavers with a Pour-A-Lid.

- Wear work gloves to protect your hands and safety goggles to protect your eyes.
- Put the appropriate base material and sand into Pour-A-Lid cavity before installing Pavers.
- Make splits where necessary using the appropriate cutting technique for your paving type.
